**Subject:** Bike and Pedestrian Plan Update

**Background:** This agenda item provides an update on several efforts as part of the larger Council initiative to implement a Bike and Pedestrian Plan across Leesburg.

Additional Bike Racks in the Downtown Area – The Economic Development Commission Task Force is working with Town staff to identify opportunities for additional bike racks. A new bike rack has been ordered for Town Hall. It should arrive in about 4-6 weeks. In addition, a bike rack is being added to Georgetown Park.

Signage to the Downtown Area from the Washington and Old Dominion (W&OD) Trail – The Leesburg Downtown Business Association is working on maps and signage to improve the visual link from the W&OD Trail (near South King Street) to downtown businesses. Town staff is facilitating this effort with the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority. This effort is expected to be completed this Fall. Additional signage is being contemplated to link the W&OD Trail with White's Ferry and the C&O Canal, both of which are major bike routes.

Bike Depot at Raflo Park – The Council approved project to add a Bike Depot at Raflo Park is virtually complete. The bike rack, water fountain, lighting, and air pump have been installed and are functional. The portable restroom will be installed by the end of the week. Final landscaping and a ribbon cutting are planned for September.

Representatives from the Leesburg Downtown Business Association (LDBA), the Economic Development Commission (EDC), and Town Staff will be available at the meeting for questions.
