Subject: Approving a waiver of fees for the Tenth Annual Battlefield Run in support of the Special Operations Warrior Foundation.

Recommendation: It is recommended that Council consider a fee waiver in the amount of \$500.00 in support of this event.

Issue: Should the Town Council waive fees associated with the Tenth Annual Battlefield Run in support of the Special Operations Warrior Foundation?

Background: The tenth annual charity motorcycle ride originates in Leesburg on September 14, 2013, and travels to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. For the first six years of the event, police support was provided by on-duty officers. In 2010, the Leesburg Police Department redirected the event to the Community Events Committee for permitting. That year, the organizers provided a certificate of insurance and paid \$500.00, which included police support and the event application fee. The 2011 and 2012 events received fee waivers from Council. All funds generated by his Charity Ride are used to support the Special Operations Warrior Foundation.

Fiscal Analysis: Staff expects to incur expenses of \$450.00 for three dedicated police officers while the event is within Leesburg, as well as the special event application fee in the amount of \$50.00; for a total event fee of \$500.00.
