TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

Subject: Requesting Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to Accept Certain Streets for Maintenance Payments.

Staff Contact: Calvin K. Grow, Transportation Engineer

Council Action Requested: The adoption of a resolution by Council is needed requesting VDOT to add certain streets to the list of streets eligible for maintenance payment.

Staff Recommendation: I recommend that hat Town Council adopt a resolution requesting the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to add the streets in the attached list to the streets eligible for maintenance payments.

Commission Recommendation: Not applicable.

Fiscal Impact: The Town of Leesburg will receive \$14,770.25 annually to maintain 1.31 lane miles of new roadway.

Executive Summary: Addition of streets for VDOT maintenance payments.

Background: Requests to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) for addition of streets for maintenance payments are due in February 2015 in order for the streets to be eligible for maintenance payments at the beginning of Fiscal Year (FY) 2016. Attached is a list of one (1) street that we recommend to be added to the eligible list. Attached is the required VDOT form and Council Resolution required by VDOT for the request.

Currently, the Town receives \$11,275 per lane mile for collector/local roads and \$19,202 per lane mile for arterial roads, resulting in total annual maintenance funds of \$3,233,647.14 for FY 2015. The Town has 50.32 lane miles of arterial roads and 201.10 lane miles of collector/ local roads. Based on the attached tabulation, the Town will gain 1.31 lane miles of collector/ local roads increasing the total of all lane miles to 252.73. The new total maintenance funds for FY 2016 will be \$3,248,417.39 after VDOT approves the proposed additions.
