Reference: Request for Appointees to NVTA's Planning Coordination Advisory Committee

Dear Chairman York:

As you may be aware, in the spring of 2007, the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA) requested that the towns embraced by any county in the Authority, designate appointees to the NVTA's Planning Coordination Advisory Committee (PCAC), as called for in the General Assembly legislation creating the NVTA. At the time the request was made, the Authority was working to implement HB 3202. Although appointees were received, since that request, HB 3202 was ruled unconstitutional, there were national and local elections and the Governor and the General Assembly approved HB 2313. As the Authority works to implement HB 2313, I am asking for your help in designating new individuals for this committee.

The legislation mandated that the PCAC, "shall include, but not be limited to, at least one elected official from each town that is located in any county embraced by the Authority and receives street maintenance payments under § 33.1-41.1." We are asking that elected officials from NVTA jurisdictions, but not on the NVTA, participate on this committee by appointing a member. In addition to the representatives from the officials from NVTA jurisdiction, the NVTA is also requesting that the Mayors of each town embraced by the Authority designate someone to participate on this committee as well. We believe this will provide a diverse representation of viewpoints from across the region as the NVTA considers important transportation projects and plans. A full description of this committee's charge is attached to provide more guidance.

With NVTA's expanded role in regional transportation resulting from the passage of HB 2313, we feel it is critical to reestablish this committee as soon as possible. To accomplish this, we ask that you send your suggestions and designees to Monica Backmon, Chairman of the Jurisdiction and Agency Coordinating Committee ([mbackmon@pwcgov.org](mailto:mbackmon@pwcgov.org)); (703) 703-792-6273; (703) 792-8150 – fax) by Thursday, June 20, 2013.



## The Northern Virginia Transportation Authority

### PLANNING COORDINATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

*§ 15.2-4837. Formation of advisory committees.*

*The Authority also shall have a planning coordination advisory committee, which shall include, but not be limited to, at least one elected official from each town that is located in any county embraced by the Authority and receives street maintenance payments under § 33.1-41.1.*

The legislation that created the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority also required that the Authority have a planning coordination advisory committee (PCAC). The charge of the PCAC is noted below.

#### **Planning Coordination Advisory Committee (PCAC)**

- (1) **Charge.** This committee shall be responsible for advising the NVTA on broad policy issues related to the periodic update of the NVTA's Long Range Transportation Plan (e.g., TransAction 2030) and the development of the NVTA's Six Year Program with special consideration to regional transportation, land use and growth issues and provide advisory recommendations to the NVTA.
- (2) **Membership.** All members shall be elected officials from jurisdictions embraced by the NVTA. Such membership shall include, as a minimum, one elected official from each town that is located in any county embraced by the NVTA and receives street maintenance payments.
