

September 1, 1937

At a special meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, held in the Council Chamber on Wednesday, September 1, 1937, at 8:00 P. M., there were present Lucas D. Phillips, Mayor; Roscoe B. Rhoads, Recorder; and Roy W. Flippo, John T. Hourihane, Lawrence S. Hutchison, Louis C. Rollins, John D. Taylor and Joseph H. Turley, Councilmen.

On motion of Councilman Turley, seconded by Councilman Hutchison, and unanimously carried, the following Ordinance was unanimously adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, that the Recorder be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to include in the records of this meeting the oaths of office taken by the different town officials.

### OATH OF OFFICE

STATE OF VIRGINIA, County of Loudoun, to-wit:

Recorder Roscoe B. Rhoads presented his resignation, and upon motion of Councilman Filippo, seconded by Councilman Hutchison, and unanimously carried, the following resolution was passed:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, that the resignation of Roscoe B. Rhoads, Recorder for the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, be and the same is hereby accepted.

It was moved by Councilman Rollins, seconded by Councilman Hutchison, and unanimously carried, that the following Ordinance be adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, the Roscoe B. Rhoads, be and he is hereby elected, appointed and employed as Auditor-Treasurer of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, from the date of this ordinance to the 31st. day of August, 1939, at the salary of \$1,500.00 per annum, payable \$125.00 per month. The duties of the said Auditor-Treasurer shall consist of the duties heretofore imposed upon him by Ordinances and Resolutions and also such other duties as may be hereafter imposed upon him by the Council of the said town.

On motion of Councilman Rollins, seconded by Councilman Hutchison, and unanimously carried, the following Ordinance was adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, that the sum required to pay the premium on a bond in the sum of \$5,000.00 for the Treasurer of the town of Leesburg for a period of one year starting September 29, 1937, and ending one year thereafter, be and the same is hereby appropriated.

It was moved by Councilman Hutchison, seconded by Councilman Turley, and unanimously carried, that the following Ordinance be adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, that on and after September 1, 1937, all money belonging to the town shall be deposited in one or both of the banks located in said town by the Auditor-Treasurer in the name of the "Town of Leesburg -- By Roscoe B. Rhoads, Treasurer."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all checks drawn against any account of the "Town of Leesburg" shall be signed by the Treasurer, and counter-signed by the Mayor of said town.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Recorder be and he is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Loudoun National Bank of Leesburg, Virginia, and a copy thereof to The Peoples National Bank of Leesburg, Virginia.

On motion of Councilman Rollins, seconded by Councilman Turley, and unanimously carried, the following Ordinance was adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, that Louis T. Titus be and he is hereby elected and appointed Recorder for the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, for a period of two years, starting September 1, 1937, and ending August 31, 1939.

It was moved by Councilmen Turley, seconded by Councilmen Hutchison, and unanimously carried, that the following Ordinance be adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the town of Leesburg, in Virginia, that the present Town Sergeant, John F. Thompson, be and he is hereby continued in office until the 13th. day of September, 1937 or until his successor is appointed, whose salary shall be at the rate of \$100.00 per month.

Mayor Phillips addressed a few remarks to the Council stating some of the needs of the town.

Auditor-Treasurer Rhoads directed a few remarks thanking the Council for the recent appointment.

There being no further business, on motion, the Council adjourned.
